SCENE I - 2020 A.D.

on "side" of stage

Curtain opens on LITTLE PETER and GRANNY SMITH.
Each is dressed in Star Trek-like attire, though
Granny wears the obligatory shawl and wire-rimmed
glasses. - Granny in chair (nodding), Peterne floor beside her -

GRANNY - WELL, HOW SHALL WE ENTERTAIN YOUR FRIENDS TODAY,

PETEK? (She looks at the audience, indicating Peter's friends)

PETEK - OK, I DON'T KNOW, GRANNY, BUT THEY NEED SOMETHING SPECIAL!

GRANNY - LIKE WHAT?

PETER - WELL, THEY LIKE STORIES, BUT THEY DON'T LIKE TO SIT TOO LONG. THEY LIKE TO BE ACTIVE AND TELL STORIES, TOO!

GRANNY - WELL, WE MIGHT DO SOME SPACE STORIES -

PETEK - BUT, GRANNY, I DIDN'T SAY THEY WERE SPACEY!
WELL -- THEY ARE INTERESTED IN PROGRESS,
BUT THEY LIKE HISTORY, TOO.

GRANNY - WELL, WE MIGHT DO THE U.S. PRESIDENTS GAME -

PETEK - THAT MIGHT NOT WORK EITHER - THESE FRIENDS
BELIEVE IN EDUCATION -- BUT -- I KNOW!
LET'S DO PETER THE GREAT! HE WAS A
PRESIDENT!

GRANNY - PETEK THE GREAT??

PETER - YOU KNOW - GREAT GRANDMA'S BROTHER?

GRANNY - OH, YOU MEAN GREAT UNCLE PETER.

PETER - THAT'S THE ONE. IT'S A GREAT STORY, AND, THE END -- WELL, THAT'S WHAT'S REALLY FUN!

GRANNY - (hesitating) - WELL, YES, BUT, PETER, YOUR FRIENDS ---
YOU KNOW, GREAT UNCLE PETER DID BECOME A (stage
whisper) POLITICIAN. (she looks over her glasses at the
audience.)

PETER - YEAH, GRAN. WHAT ARE CAPITAL GAINS, ANYWAY?

GRANNY - SH-H-H, PETER! YOU KNOW WE DON'T TALK ABOUT
THAT. (Philosophically) UNFORTUNATELY, UNCLE PETER
WENT ASTRAY, BUT AS A YOUNG MAN, HE HELPED
TO CREATE SOMETHING QUITE WONDERFUL -- SOMETHING
FOR THE FUTURE --

PETER - (enthusiastically) YEAH, GRAN! LET'S DO "GREAT UNCLE
PETER'S DREAM"! - YOU KNOW: ABOUT FOUNDING A
PLACE "WHERE UVMONTEKS GO TO COLLEGE"?

GRANNY - WELL, FOR THAT MATTER, WE COULD TALK ABOUT
IRA ALLEN AND THE UNIVERSITY OF VERMONT --
(she looks speculatively at the audience)

PETEK - OH, COME OFF IT, GRAN - YOU KNOW URM ONLY ACCEPTS STUDENTS FROM MAKS NOW.

GRANNY - YES, WELL, OKAY. "GREAT UNCLE PETEK'S DREAM IT 15!" They leave

Judy - sign SCENE II - 1970 A.D.

The "spotlight" shifts to a young man wearing ^{Hippie clothes} ~~a Harvard sweatshirt~~ - BIG PETER - settling down for the night.

PETEK - WHERE! I'M BEAT. SUCH A LONG MEETING WITH BILL C GOVERNOR DAVIS! WORE ME OUT. - HOW DOES HE EVER EXPECT ME TO COME UP WITH AN ANSWER TO EDUCATING ADULT VERMONTERS, ANYWAY? I WANT TO DO SOMETHING THAT WILL "PUT A GREAT FUTURE BEHIND me"! (Yawns) WELL, I'LL SLEEP ON IT TONIGHT AND THINK ABOUT IT TOMORROW--

Judy - sign

(Peter drops off quickly. "Lighting" suggests a dream beginning. From stage RIGHT enters a very "intriguing" woman - beautiful, mysterious, seductive, etc. Peter "senses" her presence and becomes alert.)

PETER - HEY! WHAT'S THIS? WHERE AM I? (aside to audience) - AND ALL THAT KIND OF THING? WHO ARE YOU?

CEE CEE - (coyly) I'm CEE CEE!

PETEK - CEECEE?

CEECEE - (looking at the audience for participation) - YES.
I'M CEE - CEE - VEE!

PETEK - Do I know you?

CEECEE - (seductively) WELL, SOME DAY, PETEK YOU MAY
KNOW ME VERY WELL!

PETEK - REALLY? WELL, LET'S GET STARTED. (He goes to
her eagerly.)

CEECEE - OH, NOT SO FAST, PETER. I THINK YOU MISTAKE
ME FOR A MEMBER OF THE - UH - OLDEST
PROFESSION, MAYBE? BUT, I'M REALLY A
GREAT INSTITUTION OF THE FUTURE!

PETEK - HUH??

CEECEE - (speculatively) I THINK YOU MAY BE RIGHT
FOR ME, PETEK, BUT --

PETEK - YEAH - YEAH!

CEECEE - BUT WE HAVE TO GET TO KNOW EACH OTHER. FOR
INSTANCE, YOU NEED TO KNOW HOW I'M

SUPPORTED AND WHY I'M HERE.

PETEK - I DO?

CEE CEE - SUKE YOU DO. I'M NOT INTERESTED IN BEING A PASSING FANCY. I'M NOT JUST "SPRING BREAK" MATERIAL. I'M THE REAL THING! I WILL DEFINITELY GIVE YOU "A GREAT FUTURE TO LOOK BACK ON".

PETEK - (looking at the audience) DID I SAY THAT? - OKAY, CEE CEE, HOW DO I GET TO KNOW YOU?

CEE CEE OH, PETEK, DON'T WORRY - I'LL TAKE CARE OF THAT
 (looks at PETEK from under her eyelashes, flirtatiously, as if on stage LEFT a very strong man and a very rugged woman enters - Both flex muscles - CEE CEE returns to back of stage.)

PETEK - WHO'S THIS?

PHIL - (Staunchly) I'M PHIL!

PETEK - PHIL? PHIL WHO?

PHIL - (looking slyly at the audience) - I'M CEE CEE VEE'S PHIL - PHIL - O - SO - PHY!

PETEK (aside) OH, GOD - THAT'S AWFUL!

PHIL - AWFUL? MEET MY COUNTER PART, MISS --

PETEK - DON'T TELL ME. -

PHIL - RIGHT. MEET MISS-ION (pronounced SHUN)!

PETER - I KNEW IT!

CEE CEE (coming downstage) BUT LISTEN, PETEK - LET PHIL TELL YOU.

PHIL - WE'RE WHAT HOLDS CEE CEE TOGETHER - WITHOUT US SHE WOULD BE LIKE EVERYONE ELSE, BUT WE KEEP HER STRONG AND HELP HER TO FOCUS ON WHAT'S IMPORTANT -- THINGS LIKE:

- QUALITY EDUCATION AT AFFORDABLE PRICES
- SPECIAL ACCESS TO THE EDUCATIONAL NEEDS OF

PETEK - EDUCATION? COMMUNITIES, no doubt?

MISS SHUN - SPECIAL ACCESS FOR COMMUNITIES WHO DON'T HAVE IT.
PHIL - (continuing) - RESPONDING TO THE EDUCATIONAL NEEDS
TO OF RURAL COMMUNITIES IN UT

PETEK - EDUCATIONAL NEEDS?

PHIL - (giving up) SPECIAL ACCESS FOR UEMONTEKS WHO FOR

ONE REASON OR ANOTHER WOULD NOT BE ABLE
TO GO TO COLLEGE

PETEK - COLLEGE?

MISS SHUN

PHIL - (not breaking his stride) INNOVATIVE WAYS TO
DELIVER HIGHER EDUCATION, AND --

(From stage right enters a woman of indeterminable
age: A VERMONTER-S.R.L. PHIL and MISS SHUN leave.)

A VERMONTER-SRL - AND ME!

PETEK - YOU? WHO ARE YOU?

SRL - WELL, I'M A VERMONTER --

PETEK - WE'RE ALL VERMONTERS, FOR GOD'S SAKE, WHAT'S
SO SPECIAL ABOUT THAT?

SRL - WELL, I AM A SPECIAL VERMONTER. I'M S.R.L.

PETEK - S.R.L.

SRL - YES - I'M A (looking at the audience) SELF-
RELIANT LEARNER!

PETER - OH, BOY, NOT YOU, TOO! (looks at audience with exasperation). I'M SUPPOSED TO KNOW WHAT THAT MEANS, I SUPPOSE.

SRL - WELL, LET ME TELL YOU.

PETER - YEAH, SUKE--

SRL - YOU'LL BE IMPRESSED (looks at audience), WON'T HE? FOR ONE THING, I'VE LEARNED HOW TO LEARN. I'M ALSO AWARE OF THE WORLD AROUND ME; I'M EQUIPPED TO MAKE INFORMED DECISIONS; I THINK CRITICALLY, ACT CREATIVELY, AND GENERALLY TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR MY OWN LIFE. (Looks at audience). PRETTY NEAT, HUH?

PETER - AND, PRAY TELL, HOW DID YOU GET TO BE THIS OUTSTANDING VERMONTER? - OR WHATEVER YOU ARE?

SRL - WELL, SPENDING TIME WITH CEE CEE VEE, OF COURSE. LOTS OF THINGS HAPPEN TO SRL'S, AND WE MEET MANY PEOPLE ALONG THE WAY.

THE FIRST PERSON I MET WAS-

(Endy Dolly, wearing mink board and carrying a "crucifix" ball) blonde Edig?

- WHO'S THIS?

Bud →

PETER

DOLLY - WELL, I'M REALLY D.O.L. WHAT I DID WAS OFFER S.R.L. "INTELLECTUAL CHALLENGE AND PERSONAL ~~EMOTIONAL~~ SUPPORT" AS SHE BEGAN HER FIRST SEMESTER WITH CEE CEE. MOST PEOPLE KNOW ME AS (looks at the audience for participation) DIMENSIONS OF LEARNING!

PETER - QUITE A MOUTH FULL--

S.R.L. - AND DEFINITELY A HEAD FULL! (Pauses) I ALSO HAD ERNIE TO HELP ME OUT--

guy → (Enter ERNIE who has several "experiences" -- i.e. green eye-shade, nurse's cap, pens, duff pattern, map, camera, backpack, copy of a transcript or Learning Contract, pens, rulers, calculators, etc. -- and is dressed in military garb - DOLLY leaves.)

PETER - OKAY. ERNIE -- HM-M-M. I'VE NO CLUE, LET'S HAVE IT: YOUR REAL NAME AND WHAT IT IS YOU DO.

ERNIE - OH, OF COURSE, I'M (looks at audience) ERNEST CREDIT! - I HAVE ALL SORTS OF SPECIALTIES: CONTRACT LEARNING, TRANSFER CREDIT, ASSESSMENT OF PRIOR LEARNING, NON-COLLEGE TRAINING, SPECIAL EVALUATION, CLEP, DANES, AND, OF COURSE,

REGULAR CEE CEE UEE'S COURSES!

SRL - (enthusiastically) YES, I TOOK 30 CREDITS WORTH OF CEE CEE UEE'S COURSES, AND THE OTHER 30 CREDITS I NEEDED WERE GATHERED THROUGH A SPECIAL COURSE CALLED "EDUCATIONAL ASSESSMENT AND PORTFOLIO PREPARATION", AND --

PETEK - WAIT, WAIT! 30 CREDITS AND ANOTHER 30 CREDITS? WHAT ARE THESE CREDITS FOR?

SRL - WHY, FOR my ---

Ernie → (DEE enters. She also wears a mortar board but → carries a diploma. ERNIE and SRL leave.)

PETEK - (bewildered) WH-WH-WHKE ARE ALL THESE PEOPLE COMING FROM? (looks at DEE) I SUPPOSE YOU HAVE SOMETHING TO DO WITH THIS, TOO? -- ?

DEE - WHY, YES! I'M DEE -- A.D. REALLY, BUT THAT'S CONFUSING BECAUSE SOME PEOPLE THINK I'M AN ATHLETIC DIRECTOR. ANY HOW, I'M (looks at audience) THE ASSOCIATE DEE-GREE! NOT ONLY THAT, I'M A SELF-DESIGNED ASSOCIATE DEGREE!

PETEK - OH, YES, OF COURSE, (Looks at audience) I SHOULD as Dee leaves

HAVE KNOWN! SO, LET ME PUT SOME OF THIS TOGETHER: CEE CEE UEE IS A COLLEGE - RIGHT? (looks at CEE CEE) - WITH A STRONG MISSION / PHILOSOPHY - OKAY? (looks at CEE CEE again) - "WHERE VERMONTERS GO TO COLLEGE" TO BECOME SELF-RELIANT LEARNERS. AM I CATCHING ON?

CEE CEE - (cheering) YES! YES!

PETER - (continuing) THEY ARE CHALLENGED, SUPPORTED, AND OFFERED VARIOUS WAYS TO EARN CREDIT TOWARDS AN ASSOCIATE DEGREE - HOW AM I DOING? (looks at audience for approval) - BUT WHAT ARE THESE DEGREES IN? WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

Scene III - 2020 A.D.

L. PETER -

HERE COMES THE GOOD PART!

GRANNY -

YES - ARE YOU READY NOW?

L. PETER -

I THINK SO -

(Scene shifts back to BIG PETER)

PETER - SO, CEECEE, I THINK I'M INTERESTED IN YOU -

CEECEE - YEAH? (She saunters over to him, seductively)

PETER - BUT THERE'S ONE MORE THING: WHO MAKES IT HAPPEN IN THE TWELVE SITES? WHO GETS INSTRUCTORS? WHO ADVISES STUDENTS? WHO GETS THE WORD OUT TO THE COMMUNITY OR FIGURES OUT WHAT THE STUDENTS NEED IN EACH COMMUNITY? WHO -- ?

CEECEE - OH, PETER, THAT'S EASY! (She looks at the audience and back at Peter. Then she points to the coordinators/audience) - THEY DO - ALL OF THE COORDS - over COORDINATORS!

Judy signs

Dick →
The Coords → (little Peter bursts on stage as the "stage" COORDS line up behind him to lead "The Coordinator Song")

L. PETER - Yes, you - (looks for audience participation) THE COORDINATORS -- OF -- INSTRUCTION -- AND -- ADVISEMENT AND THE COORDINATORS -- OF -- STUDENT -- SUPPORT -- SERVICES - ^{YOU} ARE THE ONES WHO MAKE IT ALL HAPPEN! UNCLE PETER'S DREAM CAME TRUE BECAUSE OF YOU AND THE WORK YOU DO - (little Peter sings as THE COORDS begin "The Coordinator Song" - Allcast members join them on stage. For the refrain, little Peter indicates that the audience must join in as he passes out winds to them.)

FINALE: THE COORDINATORS' SONG
